Our Learning Web this term - Being a Sporting Giant



Maths

This term we will continue to apply and practise our 4 operations. We will continue our work on fractions and begin to understand decimals. We will look at shape and space and work on measures including time.

We will be looking at data handling and applying this in other subjects too.



PHSE

We will be talking about our feelings and emotions and how to form and maintain healthy relationships. In Summer 2 we will explore the role of money in their own and other's lives, including looking at budgeting and enterprise.

History

In History we will delving into the past to find more about the ancient Greeks and why they were the origins of 'Being a Sporting Giant'. We will also find more about their way of life and the beliefs. We'll link with literacy through our research skills and read about some of the famous myths from the time. During our studies we will also step back in time as we spend a day back in ancient Greece as we are visiting by History off the Page. The people of ancient Greece left more than sporting legacies and we will find a little more about these.



Geography

Our geography study will be closely linked in with our history study this term, as we learn more about the European map. We will find more about Greece where our history studies take us, both physical and human aspects. We can compare aspects of the UK to Greece.

Literacy

We will be linking our Literacy in with other areas of the curriculum and be studying aspects of Greek myths, including some of the less sporting giants of Greek mythology! We will be exploring other text types including letters, diaries, scripts and poetry. We will be writing in these genres, learning what features to include.

In reading, we need to continue to build our stamina for reading and work on fluency. We will continue to develop comprehension skills through study of vocabulary, inference, prediction, evaluation, retrieval and summarising.

We will continue to work on speaking and listening and language skills, developing vocabulary and confidence to present effectively.



MFL

We will be continuing our Spanish with Mrs Scott this term. Our focus will be learning about family and how to ask about brothers and sisters and parents.



Science

In science we will be investigating aspects of the living world that include animals and humans. We will find out more about the importance of nutrition and food chains in the animal world; why we have skeletons and muscles; find out about the digestive system and the importance of teeth.

We will investigate how environments may change and how this may endanger habitats, as well as learn a little of animals have adapted to environments over time. We will also be learning about grouping and classification.



RE

This term our main focus is Islam. We shall first ask the question, 'What do Muslim's believe about god?' We will look at the importance of Allah and Muhammed in the Islamic faith. Our next question to explore is, 'What difference does being a Muslim make to everyday life?'

Computing

We will be using the internet for research, presenting our learning with software and learning to code with Scratch.

Art

Inspired by our history theme, we will be creating Greek vases, using paper craft to create masks and mimicking style of architecture.



P.E.

PE this term is with Mr Larkin and Mrs Scillitoe. They will be developing skills, stamina and resilience in athletics, cricket and rounders. The children will be put to the test with problem solving activities.



Music

In music we be singing, playing instruments and composing. This term we will be working on music and mood. Later this term we will also learning songs for our whole school performance.
